Practice day offers visitors far more opportunity to freely explore Augusta National! The rules on photography are relaxed and access to the course is far less restricted. All souvenir items are available in the shop, which often sells out on tournament days. The whole atmosphere is just far more relaxed and enjoyable. The biggest bonus of all is that you are allowed to take a camera into the event and take as many pictures as you wish. Phones are banned all week and all cameras are banned on competition days. Now I don't know one single person who doesn't want a handful of images of themselves at every special point around the Augusta course on Masters week.

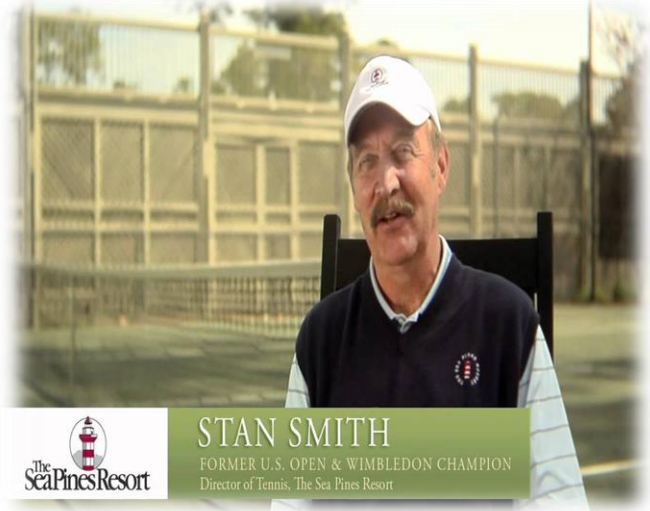
